- ARRA (American Recovery and Reinvestment Act) set aside \$19 billion in the U.S. from 2011-2015 for hospitals to satisfy government mandates
- 5,315 hospitals in the United States / EST ½ have NOT met requirements
- 7 out of 15 Measures hospitals must meet to satisfy "Meaning Use" involve Medication administration – Bar coding is essential for tracking dispensed medication and verification of patient identity.
- Continuity of Care between Caregivers




- Drug related mortality lawsuits = \$77 Billion year
- 98,000 deaths contributed by medical errors
- Studies show that many medication errors (39%) occur at the time prescribers order medications
- 45% of Americans have been affected by incomplete medical charts and drug interactions

#### Infection Control Initiatives Prevent HAI's

#### Spraying is Not Enough

- Most EPA-registered disinfectants suggest a <u>10-minute</u> <u>dwell time</u>. Otherwise, the disinfectant may not be as effective. Spraying a surface followed by a quick wipe with a paper towel is not sufficient to reduce bio-load.
- Centers for Disease Control Guidelines for Infection Control in Health Care Facilities suggest the disinfection of computer equipment stored on rolling stands, should be done <u>several times a day</u> prior to entrance and upon exit of a patient care area/room.

ISO22196 Certified Healthcare Enclosures

#### **Anti-Microbial**

- Silver ION additives mixed with plastics during manufacturing.
  - Inhibits the growth of microorganisms such as germs and bacteria (ISO22196)

#### **ISO22196 Certification**

 The ISO 22196 method is designed to quantitatively test the ability of plastics to inhibit the growth of microorganisms or kill them. Managed by EPA
 (environmental protect agency)


#### **Bedside Point of Care**



# Direct Part Marking (DPM)



- Surgical instruments are extremely difficult to tag with labels/RFID
- Direct Part Marking (DPM) Technology is most suitable
- Bar code is encoded directly on the instrument using laser etching, dot peening/embossing
